

Sample Farm Tour & Safari

- Day 1 Arrive Lusaka. Transferred to Chisamba Safari Lodge. Situated 1 half hours drive from Lusaka. Chisamba Safari lodge is built within a private game park. Guests are accommodated in thatched A-framed chalets with en suite bath and toilet facilities.

Afternoon tour of Golden Agricultural Research Trust (Gart) Zambia's top Agricultural Research station.

Stay at Kanyemba Lodge. A owner run operation situated on the Banks of the Zambezi River. Activities include game cruises, Fishing, game drives, walks and canoeing

- Day 5 Day spent in partaking in one of the many activities available

- Day 7 Fly to Mfuwe Airport in South Luangwa National Park. Met on arrival. Visit Luangwa Conservation project and Chilly farm. Learn how rural farmers grow chillies, which are crushed And mixed with engine oil and put on string and they use this to Fence their crops and keep our raiding elephants.
Head for Mfuwe Lodge, which is **situated** within the South Luangwa National Park. This park is probably one of the best parks in Africa. It is renowned for its Luangwa River, which floods its banks each year. When the water subsides it leaves numerous lagoons and oxbow lakes, home to a variety of wildlife and bird species. Luangwa Is famed for its large concentrations of wildlife including elephant, buffalo, leopard, lion, wild dog. It has Thornicraft Giraffe, Cooksons Wildebeest and Crayshaw Zebra all endemic to South Luangwa National Park.
Check into Mfuwe Lodge. A luxury lodge built on a private lagoon. Guests are accommodated in thatched A-framed chalets with en suite facilities.
Lunch Mfuwe Lodge
Evening game drive. **Overnight Mfuwe Lodge – all inclusive of all Meals and activities.**

Early morning game drive or walk with professional guide

Transfer to Mfuwe airport and fly to Livingstone. Transfer to Islands of Siankaba. A luxury safari lodge. Guests are accommodated in Tents on stilts built on the banks of the Zambezi River. Each tent has en suite shower and toilet facilities
Afternoon sundowner cruise on Zambezi River – including drinks and snacks.

Day 10

Tour of the famous Victoria Falls on the Zambian side of the river, optional helicopter flight over the Falls
Lunch Livingstone Island. Livingstone Island is a small Island where David Livingstone first saw Victoria Falls from. Guests will get a Chance to swim on the edge of Victoria Falls and will be served Lunch on the island.
Return to the Lodge late afternoon
